The Public Services Ombudsman for Wales (PSOW) is an independent organisation that deals with complaints about public services provided by:

- Local councils
- The National Health Service (NHS)
- Housing associations

A **public service** is a service provided by an organisation that is part of the Government.

# Police and Crime Commissioners (PCCs)



Police and Crime Commissioners are elected by local people to be in charge of the Police in their area.



There are 4 Police and Crime Commissioners in Wales:

One for the Dyfed-Powys Police



One for the Gwent Police



One for the North Wales Police



One for the South Wales Police

#### **Police and Crime Panels**



Each Police force in Wales has a Police and Crime Panel.

A Police and Crime Panel is an independent group of people who give advice to the Police and Crime Commissioner about:



Their plans for the local Police



How much money is spent by the local Police



 How much council tax should be paid by local people for the Police



Choosing a new Chief Constable



Police and Crime Panels are based at local councils.

### **Complaints**



Each local Police force has a way of looking into complaints.



You can get more information from each local Police force's website.



If you are not happy with the way they have dealt with your complaint, you can complain to the Chief Constable.



## Complaints about the Chief Constable

If you are not happy about the Chief Constable, you can complain to the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC).



If you are not happy about the way the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) deals with your complaint, you can complain to the Ombudsman.



# Complaints about the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC)

The Ombudsman can only look into the way the Police and Crime Commissioner dealt with your complaint.



We cannot look into your original complaint against the Police.



If you are unhappy with the Police and Crime Commissioner, you should usually complain to your local Police and Crime Panel before contacting us.

#### **Complaints against the Police**



If you have complained about your local Police and you are still unhappy, you can contact the **Independent Office for Police Conduct**.
